Activity Title	Art in Nature (Drawing with Trees)		
Activity Overview	In this activity, you will use the movement of trees to make exciting new drawings.		
Activity Duration	1 hour	Resources Required	➤ Different coloured pens, drawing paper and masking tape.
Activity Summary			
<p>Have you ever looked at the movement of trees in the wind?</p> <p>The wind makes the branches of trees move in lots of different interesting ways. A small amount of wind makes tree branches move a little, while strong wind creates lots of movement. Each different type of tree moves in very different ways too.</p> <p>Today we will turn the power of the wind into drawings by carefully attaching drawing pens to the branches of a tree and watching the tree draw!</p> <p>All you will need today is some different coloured drawing pens, a pad of drawing paper, and some masking tape.</p> <p>Make sure you only use trees with low branches that you can reach from the ground. Do not climb any trees to make your drawings.</p> <p>Make sure you are careful with the trees you decide to use for your drawings and ensure you don't damage them when you attach the pens to the branches and take them off. Make sure you take any used paper and any tape home with you or put it in a bin after you have made your drawings too.</p>
