| <p>Have you ever thought about how art is so good capturing the feeling of a place, or the emotion you felt at a particular moment? Today you will explore all of these things and create your own pictures that communicate what your local community means to you.</p> <p>Think about what makes your local community special...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• How does it make you feel?• What are its traditions and culture?• Who are the different people that live there?• What makes you proud to live there?• How could all of these different thoughts and feelings be communicated in a single picture? <p>Explore your local community and take a series of 10 photographs that capture these different ideas and feelings you have about your local community.</p> <p>Perhaps your photographs could be of the different coloured buildings in your neighbourhood, the flags that fly above the buildings, or the different food from all over the world that people in your local community eat.</p> <p>After you have taken your series of 10 photographs, choose just 1 that you feel really captures your local community and how it makes you feel.</p> <p>If you can, go with a friend or family member on your walk and always ensure you are safe.</p> | | | |
