Activity Overview	In this activity, you will make a visual re-interpretation of your favourite song or piece of music.	
Activity Steps	Notes	Resources
First, make a note of the type of visual language you could use. Sketch out different lines and shapes. Make a note of some colours and experiment with some different kinds of marks.		Paper, pencils and pens
Choose your favourite song or piece of music that you would like to reimagine as art.		Music
Listen to your song or music a couple of times first before you begin to draw. (Try closing your eyes for this so you really concentrate on the music)	How does it make you feel? What colours, lines, shapes and marks could you use to express this?	Music
When you are ready, put a blank piece of paper in front of you, start your song again and begin your drawing. Let your imagination run wild!	It might help to close your eyes at times when you are making your drawing. This will help you really relax and express yourself.	Music, paper, pens and pencils.
When you have completed your drawing, you could start a new one expressing a different type of music. Does the drawing look different depending on the different type of music?
