3 rd Research Edmond Becquerel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using the internet research Edmond Becquerel and use this information to help answer the question on the activity sheet about him. 	Pen/pencil, activity worksheet and access to the internet.
4 th Research a scientist from your country	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research a scientist from your country who has made a significant contribution to science by sharing their idea/discovery or findings worldwide. 	Pen/pencil, activity worksheet and access to the internet.
